



A few updates from EAB since the award presentation in November 2016:

Colorado Community College System

Launched our first Community College System relationship - Colorado Community College System - and had the first student register using Navigate just a few weeks ago. [Here](#) is a link to a testimonial from one student at Pueblo Community College about using Navigate.

Danville Community College

In one year, Danville Community College reduced the number of dropouts before school starts by 4.6 percentage points: an 11 percent overall increase in applicants successfully making it through orientation and onto the first day of school.”

VCCS System

EAB recently signed on the entire VCCS System to Navigate. This decision was part of their state legislature’s call to improve retention and completion rates and further implement Guided Pathways. It was spearheaded by the system and their JFF student success center.

General

EAB has also fully integrated and launched their advising and early alert module within Navigate, creating a solution that now integrates both the student and staff facing aspects of a holistic student success solution. This piece of the solution allows advisors and students to receive data that would otherwise not be available – like student behavior information being immediately available to advisors – helping better predict student need and risk proactively versus reactively. It also ensures seamless communication amongst students, advisors and broader student support staff within one platform.

EAB is fully launching the mobile app version of Navigate in the next 3 – 4 months, which will allow for mobile nudges and push notifications as an additional means to put and keep students on the appropriate pathway.

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
