- Developed Uniform Layout & Design

 - Making them less static & more customized to student's circumstances
 - Leveraging technology (Degree Planner)
 - Help inform academic course scheduling

Guided Pathways at CSN Phase III (continued)

- Current Work with Guided Pathways at CSN
 - Built Strategy into the College's Strategic Enrollment Plan to Leverage Technology to assist with Initial Enrollment, Retention and Completion
 - Began Researching CRM's in 2014
 - RFP went out in late spring 2015
 - Reviewed Several CRM's as a result of RFP

- Adopted the Hobson's CRM—Full Student Lifecycle
 - Radius—Recruitment & Admissions
 - Starfish—Early Alert
 - Starfish—Connect
 - Starfish—Degree Planner

- Degree Planner by Hobsons
 - Technology allows students to build precise, personalized degree maps
 - Helps students make decisions about their enrollment
 - Provides institutions with insight into student plans

- Degree Planner by Hobsons (continued)
 - Alerts students when they are about to go off track from their Guided Pathway (academic map)
 - Assists students in crafting an optimal class schedule taking into account the student's preferred mode of course delivery, availability for classes, FT/PT status and more

- Degree Planner by Hobsons (continued)
 - Enables advisors & counselors to review and monitor student course enrollment and their path to graduation
 - Provides intelligence on student course and program choices, which allows campus administrators to make strategic decisions based on accurate curriculum and class forecasting

CSN will have "Degree Planner" Fully Implemented in Spring 2019

- Leading Indicators (Early Momentum Metrics)
 - % of students who attempted 15/30 in one term/year
 - % of students who pass college level English and/or Math in one year
 - % of students who pass at least 9 college-credits in the student's field of study in year one
 - Persisted from term one to term two
 - Total college credits attempted
 - Total college credits completed
 - ▶ Credit pass rate





 - Mandatory Academic Advising Before 1st Semester Enrollment
 - ▶ Provided Academic Map Before 1st Semester Enrollment,
 - ► Encouraged to Enroll in Math and English in 1st Semester
 - ▶ Required Advising Session Prior to 2nd Term Enrollment


1ST TERM TO 2ND TERM PERSISTENCE




TERM TO TERM PERSISTENCE AFRICAN AMERICAN STUDENTS




TERM TO TERM PERSISTENCE HISPANIC STUDENTS




TERM TO TERM PERSISTENCE PELL STUDENTS




SUCCESS INDICATORS—ALL STUDENTS




SUCCESS INDICATORS—AFRICAN AMERICAN
